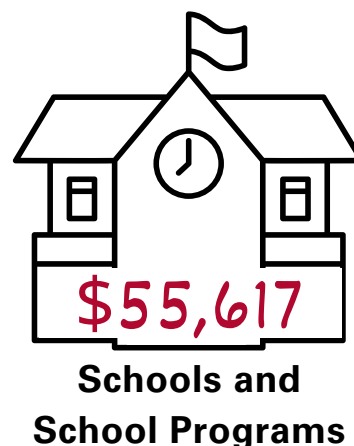
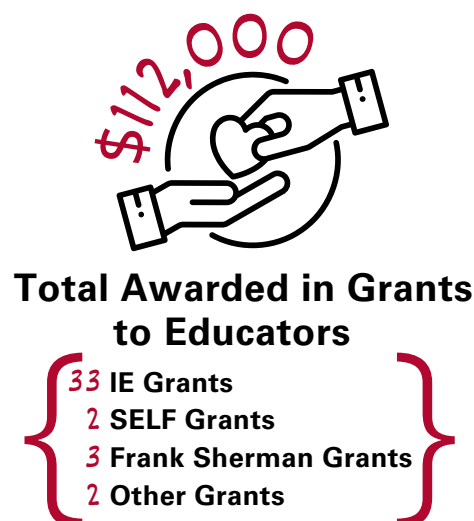

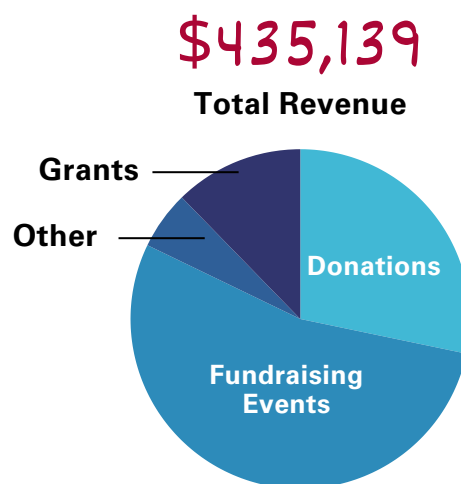

Printmaking Program Expansion

THS students get creative through SEF grant

Thanks to a 2023-24 SEF Innovative Educator Grant, Thurston High School teacher Perry Joseph introduced students to the art of printmaking. The program allowed students to explore woodcut, linocut, collagraph, and monotype techniques.

Building on its success, Joseph secured a second IE Grant for 2024-25. "Printmaking 2" will enhance the program with advanced projects, consumable supplies, and permanent studio items. This year, students are mastering color reduction woodcuts and diving into new techniques with the new high-quality materials provided by this grant funding.

"The kids are loving printmaking and are proud of their work," shared Perry Joseph. "It engages them with school, anchors them, and provides a space where they can thrive and build self-confidence."

Notably, three students from the program were juried into the Teen Mayor's Art Show in September 2024, with one earning two entries—a testament to their talent and dedication.
